If you are able to live and work on Cape Cod, congratulations! It's so beautiful here...

But how about those who have a job, but can't afford a home here any longer? Those just starting out: school teachers, nurses, fire and police men and women. People who work in hotels and restaurants? Perhaps even your own administrative staff or those who help your business with their services?

Since its founding 15 years ago, CHAMP Homes, a program of Housing For All Corp., has served some 1,000 Cape Cod residents with supportive and affordable housing. They in turn have provided countless hours of service to the communities and added to the growth of our economy.

You already know that affordable housing is the number one issue on Cape Cod. The good news is that Housing For All Corporation continues to work on new solutions. We've made a pledge to help create more housing with affordable rent for hard working citizens.

But, we need your support! You probably receive many requests for support from different organizations. That's why I'd like to offer you a simple, new way to go the extra mile, but you don't have to walk it yourself!

CHAMP Homes/Housing For All Corporation are participating once again in the 14<sup>th</sup> Annual Housing With Love Walk, 108 miles from Provincetown to Falmouth, July 10<sup>th</sup> through 16<sup>th</sup>, 2006. Proceeds will benefit the homeless on the Cape and support work force housing.

Please consider sponsoring a mile or a portion thereof, to be named after your business or after someone you'd like to honor or memorialize. The sooner you sign up the more coverage you will receive in the Cape Cod Times and in other ways in the time leading up to the Walk.

This recognition of your support will publicly show how you and your business care about finding a solution for the housing problem on Cape Cod.

We need to raise \$50,000 by June 30th. You can sponsor a mile for \$500 or a quarter mile for \$125. Donors who pledge \$2,500 will be VIP's and a segment of the Walk will be named in their honor. You can choose if you'd like to walk that 5 mile stretch with us or have us walk it for you. If you respond now by April 15th, you can choose which mile marker you sponsor and what you'd like it to say.
